| Councils." The district uses a web filtering device called "ContentKeeper." The  |
| filter works based on website classifications such as: entertainment,  |
| pornography, news, education, games, etc. Inappropriate keywords are also  |
| filtered for students and employees. School administrators are notified if a   |
| student or employee has attempted to access inappropriate web materials on a   |
| school computer. There are different filtering thresholds for default, students  |
| use, and employee use. Students are taught safe internet use and digital   |
| citizenship. Our school celebrates White Ribbon Week sponsored by the PTA  |
| to teach students and families about digital citizenship and internet safety.  |
| White Ribbon Week is scheduled for January 23-27.  |
