- Title 1: The Halloween Parent and Family Engagement night was a success! Families were able to come through and see the Halloween decorations, and students visited stations for treats and other treasures. We will most likely do it again next year. We were able to get some extra funding this year through Title 1 that will mostly be spent on technology for classrooms.
