

Notes from April School Community Council

Tuesday, April 9, 2024

- Council members were welcomed by Tiffany Weidlein.
- Dondy Cheynoweth led the council in the pledge.
- Karalee Beckstead read the notes from the last council meeting.
- The council reviewed the school improvement plan for 2024-2025. Goal #1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage of students in Grades 1-3 making one year's growth in reading will increase by one percentage point. Goal #2: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage of students proficient in Grades 3-5 in math will increase by one percentage point.
- The School Safe Access Route Plan was reviewed by the council. A couple of changes need to be considered: 1) students may need some kind of help crossing on 1400 E. Flonnette, such as flashing lights. 2) It might be helpful with the traffic through the pick-up lane, if there was a right turn only sign.
