Monday, December 7, 2020

- All community council members were present.
- The members were welcomed by Farris Child, Chair.
- Melissa Warren led the council in the pledge.
- Notes from the last meeting were read by Karalee Beckstead.
- There was a discussion about Title 1 with Cami Thomas, principal. The students in Title 1 all seem to be progressing. Our school will continue to be a Title 1 school next year. We will have a little more funding for next year. We may have two Title 1 technicians receive training from U of U for the Higher Steps program. We currently have most students working in programs called Early Steps and Next Steps.
- The council reviewed TSSA Goal #2 which reads: “By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, the percent of students in grades 3-6 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will increase.” Mrs. Thomas told the council that this year we will probably be some kind of RISE Testing although the protocols will probably look different. Currently we are using iReady Math and iReady Reading. There is a goal to have students pass two lessons weekly. Teachers will be meeting with an iReady specialist at literacy collaboration meetings on January 11.
- Other:
 1. Currently there are discussions about where Larsen students will attend middle, junior high, and high school.

The public is welcome to attend an open house on Wednesday, December 16 at the Nebo District office from 4:00-6:00 p.m. to give their input.

2. Teachers have set individual goals with students. In January there will be an ice-cream reward for classes who have met their goals. Teachers will take a day to look at data and set new goals with students.
