- Bethany Clark welcomed the council and led members in the pledge.
- Title 1: The council had a discussion about funding for Title 1 for our school. We will continue to have Title 1 next year, and then we will see moving forward. Title 1 funds are based on the number of students on free and reduced lunch.
- The council reviewed data from Acadience and RISE.
- The council also reviewed the TSSA Budget for the current school year.
- The council also reviewed the TSSA Goal #2. The wording of the goal was changed slightly to read, "*By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, the percent of students in grades 3-5 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will increase by 1%.*" Wording was changed in action plan #3 to read "*we will provide*" instead of "*we will hire*".
- Other items discussed:
 - Some teachers are looking at Smartboards and iPad Pros for their classrooms.
 - We will have a discussion with teachers about the software they might want to have moving forward to support instruction. Some examples of software they might use include Reflex, Deck Toys, and Nearpod. The district will continue to use iReady for reading and math.
