

Notes from November School Community Council

Monday, November 9, 2020

- The council was welcomed and led in the Pledge of Allegiance by Farris Child, Chair.
- Melissa Warren was excused from the meeting.
- Members present included Naomi Leighton, Katie Howard, Farris Child, Ronda Marshall, Tiffany Hawkins, and Cami Thomas (via Zoom).
- The notes from the last meeting were read by Karalee Beckstead.
- Title 1: There was not much to say about Title 1 except that things are going well, and we have been able to give reading support to many students in our school. Title 1 supports our struggling readers who do not qualify for resource support. Title 1 schedules will be more fluid this year as students move in and out of Title1. Our technicians will continue their training to keep up on their skills.
- Data Gateway: Because end-of-year RISE testing was cancelled last spring, we have no new data on the Utah State Board of Education Data Gateway.
- Other Data: Currently, we are tracking data for reading and math on our school Literacy Tracker and Math Tracker. Our literacy tracker includes data from Acadience, Benchmark Levels, iReady Reading Diagnostic, and goal setting and tracking. Our math tracker includes the data teachers want to track on specific grade levels. We also have a Title 1 Tracker to track the progress of our Title 1 students. As a school we are working on our goals with a district mentor.
- TSSA Goal #1: The council reviewed TSSA Goal #1, which is the reading goal. Language was changed in the goal to make sure it says the Acadience Assessment instead of DIBELS. DIBELS has changed its name to Acadience.
